Discussion Items

1. Abundance

- a. John 10:10 “A thief has only one thing in mind-he wants to steal, slaughter, and destroy. But I have come to give you everything in abundance, more than you expect- life in its fullness until you overflow!” TPT

2. Resolve

- a. 2 Chr. 20:17 “You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you. Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.” NIV

- b. Luke 21:19 “And by standing firm with patient endurance you will find your souls’ deliverance” TPT

3. Identity

- a. 2 Chr. 5:17 “All these were entered in the genealogical records during the reigns of Jotham King of Judah and Jeroboam king of Israel.” NIV
- b. Gal 2:20 “My old identity has been co-crucified with Messiah and no long lives; for the nails of his cross crucified me with him. And now the essence of this new life is no long mine, for the Anointed One lives his life through me – we live in union as one! My new life is empowered by the faith of the Son of God who loves me so much that he gave himself for me, and dispenses his life into mine!” TPT

4. Strength

- a. Eph. 1:13 “And because of him, when you who are not Jews heard the revelation of truth, you believed in the wonderful news of salvation. Now we have been stamped with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit.” TPT
- b. Eph. 1:19-20 “I pray that you will continually experience the immeasurable greatness of God’s power made available to you through faith. Then your lives will be an advertisement of this immense power as it works through you! This is the mighty power.”

5. Eternity

- a. Rm 8:19 “The entire universe is standing on tiptoe, yearning to see the unveiling of God’s glorious sons and daughters! TPT
- b. John 4:17 “But I’m not married, “ the woman answered. “That is true,” Jesus said.

Discussion Questions:

1. God gives us abundance, but we know we have a thief who wants to destroy us and our family. We can be encouraged that fight from victory. What does abundance mean to you? Do think most of our sisters are living in abundance?
2. How often does Satan remind us of our failures? How do we as women not let those hooks keep us in bondage?

5. Someone’s life depends on upon you Arising. Why do think it is so hard for us women to rise up?
